I. INTRODUCTION

Museum-related Laws

The first Slovene museums act was passed in 1945 and later underwent several subsequent modifications. At present the most important museum-related laws are as follows:

Cultural Heritage Protection Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia 16/08, 123/08, 8/11 - ORZVKD39, 90/12 in 111/13),

and

Exercising of the Public Interest in Culture Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia 96/02, 77/07, 56/08, 4/10, 20/11, 111/13).

Besides these umbrella laws, museum field is regulated also by several regulatory provisions and all other laws and regulatory provisions that regulate public and private sector.

Definition of a museum

According to Cultural Heritage Protection Act museum is “a permanent organisation in the service of society and its development, which

- is open to the public and
- collects,
- conserves,
- documents,
- examines,
- interprets,
- manages and
- exhibits the heritage
- and provides data thereof,

with a view to fostering awareness of the heritage, disseminate knowledge of its values and enable people to benefit therefrom;”.

This definition is in accordance with the ICOM definition of a museum:

“Article 3 - Definition of Terms

Section 1. Museum. A museum is a non-profit, permanent institution in the service of society and its development, open to the public, which acquires, conserves, researches, communicates and exhibits the tangible and intangible heritage of humanity and its environment for the purposes of education, study and enjoyment.” (ICOM Statutes art.3 para.1)

Protection of movable cultural heritage

In Slovenia for performing public service in the field of the protection of movable cultural heritage a network of museums and galleries is set. It is composed of national museums and authorised museums.

National museums are public institutions established by the State in order to ensure protection of movable property of national significance. They, as a national public service, carry out the following tasks:

- identifying, documenting, studying, interpreting and evaluating movable and living heritage, and presenting it to the public,
- collecting and carrying out the accession and keeping of records on movable heritage,
- preparing proposals for the proclamation of movable monuments of national significance,
- coordinating entries recording movable heritage in the register,
- protecting and keeping collections of national significance,
- preparing and carrying out conservation-restoration procedures on movable heritage within its field of operation,
- supervising the protection of movable monuments and national treasures outside museums,
- advising and giving instructions to owners of collections of movable heritage regarding the keeping of inventory ledgers in its field of operation,
- exhibiting museum collections,
- researching movable heritage and means of protecting it on behalf of the ministry in the field of operation to which it belongs, and
- implementing programmes for fostering awareness of heritage, traineeship and training programmes, and practical training for educational programmes of various levels in the field.

Authorised museums are registered museums which have been granted authorisation for carrying out the national public museum service. In an authorised museum, the State financially supports the carrying out of the following activities as a national public service:

- identifying, documenting, studying, evaluating, and interpreting movable and living heritage,
- the collection, accession, and keeping the record of the movable and living heritage,
- protecting and storing museum collections of national significance,
- cooperating in administrative procedures conducted by the Ministry,
- giving advice to owners of collections of movable heritage regarding the keeping of inventories and ledgers,
- preparing and carrying out conservation-restoration procedures on movable heritage of national significance, and
- carrying out programmes of traineeship and advanced training.

The State, on the basis of a public call or tender, contributes funds for programmes and projects also in other registered museums (museums that are listed in the Registry of museums) outside the scope of the national public service, including emergency purchases of movable heritage with

a view to completing collections of national significance and issuing guarantees allowing museum collections to be borrowed for special exhibitions.

A museum meets the requirements for entry in the Registry of museums (the Registry is kept by the Ministry of Culture, at present there are 53 museums) if:

- it provides public access to its collections,
- has elaborated a plan of physical and technical protection, and of damage insurance for collections within the museum which is confirmed by the founder,
- determines upon an entrance fee and opening times, which are announced in a visible place at the entrance to the museum, and
- meets other minimum professional, physical and technical requirements as provided for with the Slovene regulations.

The majority of museums are not in the Registry of museums. According to the last available data published by the Statistical office of Slovenia, in Slovenia in the year 2012 there were 167 museums.

II. MUSEUM STATISTICS

Museum statistics on the national level is produced by the Statistical Office of the Republic of Slovenia. Ministry of culture produces statistics for those museum and galleries that are co-financed by the Ministry on the regular basis, i. e. for 45 museums and galleries.

The Statistical Office of the Republic of Slovenia produces the data on museum statistics since 1947. With survey MUSEUMS, MUSEUM COLLECTIONS, EXHIBITION GROUNDS AND GALLERIES, SLOVENIA¹ it collects data on the activity of museums, museum collections, exhibition grounds and galleries in Slovenia. For this purpose, it collects data by type of organizations, objects in museums, performances, attendance, festivals, seminars, organizational forms, employees and financial data. The legal basis for the collection of data is the National Statistics Act (OJ RS, No. 45/1995 and No. 9/2001) and the Annual Programme of Statistical Surveys for the current year. Observation units are museums, museum collections, exhibition grounds and galleries that worked in those years.

Revision of national statistics

In Slovenia in the beginning of the year 2015 a national revision of cultural statistics had started. This revision is led by the Statistical Office of the Republic of Slovenia and is elaborated in co-operation with the National Advisory Committee for Cultural Statistics that gathers all the most important national institutions that deal with cultural statistics. This advisory body is led by the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Slovenia. In the framework of this revision all the cultural fields will be examined from the point of view of statistics, as well as cultural field on the whole. Discussed will be the definitions, methodologies and their comparability in Slovenia and internationally, the possibilities regarding coverage of different cultural fields etc. Museum field is a part of this revision.

Statistical data

Since the revision of national statistics had just started, we present in this report the data produced by the Ministry of culture of Republic of Slovenia. These data refer to the museums and galleries only, that are co-financed by the Ministry on the regular basis, i. e. to 45 museums: to 10 national museums and 35 museums, established by the local communities.

National museums

For 10 national museums the ministry dedicated from the State budget in the year 2013 13.231.470 EUR. 53,5% of these funds were spent for staff expenses, 39,6% for material costs, 6,1% for investments and 0,8% for acquisition.

Authorised museums, co-financed by the Ministry of Culture

The State may, on the basis of a public call or tender, contribute funds for programmes and projects in authorised museums and in other registered museums. On this basis it provides regular financial support to 35 museums, established by the local communities.

For 35 authorised museums established by the local communities the ministry dedicated from the State budget in the year 2013 25.801.664 EUR. 69,1% of these funds were spent for staff expenses, 28,9% for material costs, 1,7% for investments and 0,3% for acquisition.
